A Message from Fr. Torvend

Blessed be the rule breakers among us!

n this day, July 29, in 1974, eleven women were ordained as priests in the Episcopal Church, a violation of the church's practice. And, here's the kicker: they were ordained by bishops who agreed that the ordination of women to public min-

istry was long, long overdue. On a very hot day in Philadelphia's Church of the Advocate, Merrill Bittner, Alla Bozarth-Campbell, Alison Cheek, Emily Hewitt, Carter Heyward, Suzanne Hiatt, Marie Moorefield, Jeannette Piccard, Betty Schiess, Katrina Swanson, and Nancy Wittig presented themselves for ordination. A number of male clergy stood and voiced their opposition to what they considered a violation of church practice (the Episcopal Church had not yet approved the ordination of women as priests or bishops). Nonetheless, the liturgy proceeded without further interruption.

Within three years, more than 100 women were ordained for public minis-

try as priests. Today women make up almost half of those ordained to the priesthood each year in the Episcopal Church. Roughly one-third of all Episcopal priests now are female and that number is growing.

Blessed be the rule breakers whose courage can open up new vitality in Christ's Beloved Community.


