A Message from Fr. Samuel Torvend

Disruptive behavior and your safety: please read carefully

At its annual retreat on May 21, the vestry spent the majority of its time working on plans to provide heightened security and safety for staff and volunteers working in the office, Wells Hall, and the church, for those who rent space from us, and for those who come to worship in Trinity Chapel and the church. This is a high priority for vestry and staff.

Before the pandemic and since our return to in-person worship, parish gatherings, and office hours, we have had persons enter our spaces: **some benign**, just seeking a bit of food, and **others disruptive**, usually due to some form of mental illness. It is the latter that concerns us here. To care for the safety of staff, volunteers, renters, and worshippers, the Christ Church staff has agreed to the following:

If a person or persons exhibiting disruptive behavior come on church property, they will be asked to leave. If a person or persons who have exhibited disruptive behavior in the past come on church property, they, too, will be asked to leave. If they refuse to leave, staff, vestry members, or volunteers will call the Tacoma Police and ask that a police officer and a crisis intervention officer take the person under their care.

It is important to bear in mind that a person in a *psychotic state* can appear pleasant and calm one minute and aggressive and threatening the next minute. The need to remove someone who can threaten or disrupt takes into consideration the number of parishioners who cannot move quickly to an exit in order to avoid potentially harmful behavior. The safety of those who come to worship or work at Christ Church is our first concern.

We kindly ask that all members of Christ Church exercise caution and **not admit** persons unknown or persons who have exhibited disruptive behavior to the church entryway, the sanctuary, Trinity Chapel, the office space or parish library, and Wells Hall. If you encounter someone who asks to be admitted, kindly go outside with doors closed behind you and ask what the person seeks. Then return to the space, closing the door, and seek a staff person or vestry member to assist the person.

Perhaps thirty years ago, we would not need to consider such measures. But now, we find ourselves needing to take measures to ensure the safety and security of those who work and worship at Christ Church.


Sunday, July 9 11:45 am in the Parish Library Earth Ministry


Call for Volunteers!
